



## Biography

The Charlie Fox band is a soul band from Denver, Colorado. Fox grew up singing gospel music in church, and started writing music at the age of 15. Being a 90's kid, her influences came from the big voices of Mariah Carey and Christina Aguilera. Christina's ***Back to Basics*** album prompted her to research the great artists of the past such as Etta James, Otis Redding, Nina Simone, Aretha Franklin and many more. After discovering Amy Winehouse's ***Back to Black*** album, Fox was inspired to dig deep and write with sincerity about her own personal life experiences.

Fox met Kyle Jones (producer, bass), who owns the Sleeping Brotherhood Studio, in 2014. After originally starting a writing project to send songs to other artists, Jones convinced Fox to keep her music and record an EP. The EP is where her musical style was born. The documentary Muscle Shoals also played a part in the idea of tracking all instruments together live in the studio. Fox wrote the lyrics and chords, and everyone would show up to the studio to lay down tracks. It became more like a series of late-night jam sessions. Each player brought their own bits of flavor to the music. Fox released her debut album, ***Alive***, in 2018.

Since recording ***Alive***, Fox has gone on a personal journey. Leaning toward her Gospel roots, for the sound of her sophomore album, ***The Road*** tells a story of change and growth. ***The Road*** was released on January 19, 2023.
